

- Provides financial incentives to Eligible Hospitals and Eligible Professionals for the adoption and meaningful use of EHRs.
- Supported by Widespread Outreach and Provider Education
- More than \$584 Million in incentive payments issued to hospitals and professionals in

Electronic Prescribing (eRx) Clearinghouse

- Agency administers and maintains the Florida E-Prescribing Clearinghouse as a dedicated website: <u>FHIN.net/eprescribing</u>

Telehealth



- Agency was designated to administer the Florida Telehealth Advisory Council during 2017-2018
 - Experts and thought leaders convened to make recommendations for expanded adoption and utilization statewide
 - Catalyst for current Telehealth legislation and initiatives

Medicaid Coverage for Telehealth Services

- Medicaid rules updated to include payment for direct, real-time audio/visual, store and forward, and remote patient monitoring services
- Medicaid Managed Care Plans are required to cover telehealth as a modality for any service they cover for in-person treatment or care





- Established in 2011
- Self-sustained through participant fees
- Streamlined, Low-Cost Infrastructure:
 - Connectivity to the national eHealth Exchange



Encounter Notification Service (ENS)

Encounter Notification Service (ENS)

Real-time notification of patients' health care encounters

- Hospitals, nursing homes, and other providers electronically send real-time ADT feeds to ENS
- Health plans, Accountable Care Organizations (ACOs), hospitals, and other providers supply a panel of patients on whom they would like alerts
- ENS incorporates a matching process to find ADT messages that match an identity on the panel



The alert is transferred from the ENS system to the subscribing entity or entities

Better Health Care for All Floridians Subscriber determines how alerts are delivered



Data Sources



Hospital Data Sources –

- More than 225 Florida hospitals
 - 97% of acute care hospital beds
 - 86% of inpatient rehab hospital beds
- Real-time automated data feeds

Actively working to add Nursing Homes as data sources to ENS

 More than 140 have signed participation agreements







11 Million individual patient identities included

1.7 Million (average) alerts delivered per month

- 12 health systems in Central and South Florida (collectively comprised of 80 hospitals)
- 25 Accountable Care Organizations (ACOs)



Query-Based Clinical Data Exchange

Powered by eHealth Exchange[®]

Connection to the nationwide eHealth Exchange

- Allows providers to query for patient clinical records
- Federated network with no centralized data repository
- Common data standards, legal agreement, and governance
